SASCC Code of Conduct

The Saratoga Area Senior Coordinating Council is a community-based nonprofit organization dedicated to improving the lives of older adults in our community. Participation in the organization’s programs is subject to the observance of the Center’s rules and procedures. The activities/behavior outlined below are strictly prohibited. Any participant or staff member who violates this code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the program and revocation of membership. Revoked memberships will be refunded at a prorated rate.

- Abusive language, discourtesy or rudeness towards any individual, group or staff member.
- Appropriate attire is required according to each activity, program or service.
- Bringing alcohol or illegal substances onto SASCC premises.
- Bringing to the center dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons, or other similar items.
- Actual or threatened violence or conducting endangerment of life, safety, health or well-being toward any individual, group or staff member.
- Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any member or staff member.
- Engaging in racial, religious, political or sexual harassment of any individual, group or staff member.
- Failing to cooperate with a staff member or organizational leader.
- Abuse of the center or its contents, including misuse, theft or abuse of the building, equipment or supplies.
- Touching or moving other people’s personal items without the owner’s permission. If you find something that you think may be lost or abandoned, notify staff. SASCC is not responsible for lost or stolen property.

If you are a victim or witness to any of these actions or behaviors, please report to staff immediately. All complaints will be investigated by SASCC management and all determinations and decisions are final.

SASCC Liability Release
